“Expressions of the Sea” Exhibition at The Mere Grange Gallery

Thursday 25th November will see the launch of a new group exhibition at the Mere Grange Gallery in St Helens. “Expressions of the Sea” showcases work by eleven locally based artists, all of whom have been inspired in different ways by our coastlines.
